 - d. Suggested hanging a poster at the Concession Stand encouraging new members.
 - e. General encouragement of members to attend regular meetings (3rd Monday of month at 7 pm).
 - f. Promote the benefit of being eligible for a \$1,000 Booster Club Scholarship after working 80 hours during the students four years of high school.
2. **Concession stand schedule:** Schedule was discussed and names listed of volunteers.
3. **Indoor concession discussion:** Music has chosen to take over 100% of the operations of the indoor concession stand. Booster Club will no longer be involved in these activities. Because of this, there are now two commercial-grade pizza ovens for sale at \$50 each (retail was \$90). These ovens were used for only one year.

1. **Football Helmet promotion** – Will be on traveling display to solicit interest. Wayne Sargent requested that tickets be printed off with the appropriate raffle license number. Consensus to print 1,000 tickets. Tickets shall be sold for \$1.00 each or 6 for \$5.00.
