Policy	343.1	Adult Diploma Program

- Adults are eligible to participate in this program at age 20 or older. They must have attended Kewaskum High School and/or be a resident of the Kewaskum School District.
- A total of 24 credits is necessary for graduation. Students who entered the ninth grade with a graduation year of 1996 or before will only need 22 credits. Included in the 24 credits must be.

English	4 credits
Social Studies	3 credits
Science	2 credits
Math	2 credits
Health	0.5 credits
Physical Ed	1.5 credits
Computer Literacy	0.5 credits (or equivalent)

- Credit may be given for classes attended while out of school after proof of attendance is presented.

All correspondence courses, technical school courses, and military courses must be reviewed by the Principal or designee before credit can be issued. A general rule is for each one half credit earned, a student must spend 60-70 hours with the instructor.
- Work experience may be considered to a maximum of one credit. Participation as an apprentice will also be considered to a maximum of one credit.
- Consideration will be given for the successful completion of the General Education Development (GED) program and/or the High School Equivalency Program (HSED). A maximum of one credit will be issued for each program.
