<b>Policy</b>	<b>346</b>	<b>EEN Assessment Testing</b>

The Board of Education, its designee, or affected parent may determine not to administer state or other tests to a student enrolled in an Exceptional Educational Needs (EEN) program, or may modify the format and/or administration of the tests for students with exceptional educational needs.

The Individual Education Program (IEP) of an Exceptional Educational Need (EEN) student will indicate whether or not the student will participate in state and District assessment tests, or list the subject/content areas that are appropriate for testing as well as any modifications in test administration that are necessary on a case by case basis.
