Policy	353.2	Outside Speakers and Programs

Guest speakers may be used in the classroom with approval of the Building Principal and/or his/her designee. The Building Principal shall be informed of the nature of the speech topic and shall approve the guest speaker before a commitment is made to the speaker and/or before the speaker is allowed to talk to the class.

If the topic appears to be of a controversial nature, a written rationale may be requested by the Building Principal and/or his/her designee. In this case, the Principal will review and discuss the rationale with the teacher involved before making a decision. Additionally, if a speaker such as this is approved, the administration will make an effort to notify parents in advance about the upcoming potentially controversial speaker.
