To more effectively meet the needs of identified Chapter I students, the Kewaskum School District will carry out the following policy:

As students are identified for qualification in the Chapter I program, parents shall be contacted by letter and/or telephone stating how and why their child was chosen for the program.

In early Fall, an orientation meeting shall be held to introduce the Chapter I staff and explain the program. At this meeting, parents are also informed of, and requested to participate in, the parent involvement activities. These may include parent-teacher conferences, open house, parent training sessions, make-and-take workshops, and special programs.

It is the intent of the Kewaskum School District to ensure that individual parents are effectively informed of their children's progress and encouraged and assisted in efforts to sustain or enhance that progress. Parents' suggestions in the planning, development and operation of the program will be solicited throughout the year. A parent-staff district Chapter I advisory committee will meet to provide input into the program.
