Procedure	422P	Admission of Nonresident Students

The Board of Education shall base its decision for admission on the following:

1. The submission of evidence of the establishment of legal residence within nine weeks after entering school. The Board requires a deposit of \$100 at the time the child enters school. This deposit is refundable if residency is established within nine weeks. Should residency not be established within nine weeks the deposit will be applied toward the tuition charge. Tuition shall be prorated based on the actual previous year's tuition as certified to the State of Wisconsin. A written agreement shall be made between the Board and the student's parents or guardian for the payment of tuition. The Board may waive the nine-week limitation for residency if the situation so warrants.
2. Nonresident, non-open enrollment children may be allowed to attend the School District of Kewaskum providing advance approval has been given by the Board. A written agreement shall be made with the child's parent/guardian for the payment of tuition. One semester of tuition must be paid prior to enrolling for the semester.
3. A student who is enrolled at the beginning of the school year may complete that particular school year without paying tuition, even though his/her parents move out of the District.
4. Students who have gained 12th grade status and are residents of the District at the time of gaining such status, may be permitted to complete the 12th grade without payment of tuition even though their parents are nonresidents.
5. Minor students not living with parents or a legal guardian, or emancipated minors will be admitted only upon favorable Board of Education action.
6. Transportation for nonresident, non-open enrollment students is the responsibility of the parents, except as provided for children with exceptional educational needs.
