<b>Policy</b>	<b>443.1</b>	<b>Student Dress Code</b>

The responsibility for the appearance of students in the School District of Kewaskum rests with the parents and the students themselves. They have the right to determine the student's dress or grooming providing that:

1. Such dress or grooming does not endanger the public health and safety of others. To this end, students are not allowed to wear or carry items that might conceal weapons or other illegal/dangerous items, or be used as a weapon itself.
2. Such dress or grooming meets the general decency standards of the Kewaskum community and the students in the various schools of the District. To this end, students may not wear to school any article of clothing that promotes the use of alcohol, cigarettes, or drugs or can be found offensive in any way to others
3. Such dress or grooming is not disruptive to the education of other students in the classroom(s) and in no way hinders the educational process. To this end students are not allowed to wear, during the school day, articles of clothing that create disruption to the learning process unless prescribed by a doctor, worn for religious purposes, or as a part of an all school activity.
