**First Offender Violation of
School Board Policy 443.4**

The above referenced meeting is held in compliance with Kewaskum School District Policy #443.4 pertaining to student alcohol and other drug use. District Policy states:

Any person who is involved in the use of, under the influence of, or in possession of alcohol, controlled substances, mood-altering substances, including look-alikes, or drug paraphernalia (as defined by state statutes), is a violation of school policy and disciplinary action will be taken. This action will include the following:

1. parent notification/conference
2. student conference
3. referral to law enforcement (charges may be filed as a result of this referral) and emergency medical assistance, if necessary
4. suspension for up to five days

AND MAY RESULT IN:

5. petitioning the Board of Education for consideration of expulsion.

For the first offense, special consideration for lessened discipline at step five (5) above may take place if the student agrees to one of the following steps:

- a. The student agrees to a drug /alcohol screening with the S. A. P. coordinator and agrees to follow his/her recommendation.
- b. The student and parent agree to end alcohol and other drug assessment provided at a state approved alcohol /drug agency in the community and agrees to follow resulting recommendations. If this option is chosen, the parent and student must consent to release of information to District as to student's participation and compliance with the recommendations.

Failure to comply with recommendations/expectations of the S. A. P. program and/or A. O. D. A. agency may result in implementation of the initial discipline recommendation. A second offense will result in a recommendation for consideration of student expulsion.
