| Policy | 443.6 | Dangerous Weapons in the Schools |

Possession and/or use of dangerous weapons, or their look alike, is prohibited in school buildings, on school grounds, at school functions or on school contracted transportation. The School District reserves the right to define a dangerous weapon when not listed by the State Statute.

Students in violation of this policy shall be subject to disciplinary action and may, depending on the offense, be referred to the police authorities for prosecution.

Students in possession of a firearm(s) on school grounds, in school buildings, at school functions, or on school contracted transportation shall be expelled in accordance with State Statute. The District Administrator may modify the expulsion requirement of the act for a student on a case-by-case basis.

Within School Property

1. Students shall not be in possession of incendiary devices or their look alike in any of the school buildings, office, shops, warehouses, vehicles or enclosed structures of the Kewaskum School District.

On School Grounds

2. Students shall not be in possession of incendiary devices or their look alike on any school grounds, playing fields, or other outdoor areas belonging to the Kewaskum School District.

At School Sponsored Events or Trips

3. No students shall be in possession of incendiary devices on any school grounds, playing fields, or other outdoor or indoor areas related to school activities, or vehicles used to transport students for school related purposes.
