Policy	443.61	Incendiary Devices in a School Setting

The possession of incendiary devices (cigarette lighters, matches, firecrackers, smoke bombs, etc.) or their look alikes on school premises is contrary to the educational goals of the Kewaskum School District. In order to carry out this philosophy, to promote the health and safety of all students and staff, and to promote the cleanliness of facilities, the Board of Education enacts the following into policy:

Within School Property

1. Students shall not be in possession of incendiary devices or their look alikes in any of the school buildings, office, shops, warehouses, vehicles or enclosed structures of the Kewaskum School District.

On School Grounds

2. Students shall not be in possession of incendiary devices or their look alikes on any school grounds, playing fields, or other outdoor areas belonging to the Kewaskum School District.

At School Sponsored Events or Trips

3. No students shall be in possession of incendiary devices on any school grounds, playing fields, or other outdoor or indoor areas related to school activities, or vehicles used to transport students for school related purposes.

Violations of this policy may result in disciplinary action against the student(s) ranging from suspension to expulsion.
