Procedure	443.7P	Student Use of Electronic Communication Devices Procedure

If a student brings a cell phone (or another electronic communication device) to school it should be turned off. After school, a student may make use of their electronic communication device in the lobby areas of the building or outside the school building. Cell phones, other electronic communication devices, or devices with photo capabilities are never allowed in the locker rooms or other dressing areas of our schools. Cell phones with photo capabilities should never be used in school.

If a student is found using a two-way electronic communication device, the supervising adult is to confiscate it immediately and to turn it into the administration. The student can retrieve it from the administrator at the end of the day. If it is a device with photo capabilities, the administration has the option of returning it or keeping it for possible further investigation.

A second violation of this policy will require a parent to meet with the administration and student.

A third or further violations will result in heavier consequences that may include suspension, recommendation for expulsion, and/or an investigation by legal authorities.
