<b>Policy</b>	<b>443.9</b>	<b>Vandalism</b>

Every citizen of the District including students, are urged by the Board to cooperate in reporting any incidents of vandalism to property belonging to the District and the name(s) of the person or persons believed to be responsible.

Each employee of the District will report to the principal of the school every incident of vandalism known to him or her and, if known, the name(s) of the person or persons responsible.

The District Administrator and/or principals are authorized to sign a criminal complaint and to press charges against perpetrators of vandalism against school property, and to delegate, if necessary, authority to sign complaints and press charges.

Any student found guilty of any form of vandalism or defacement of school property may be suspended and may be brought before the Board of Education for consideration of expulsion.

Full restitution for the damage caused will be sought from such persons or, in the case of minors, from their parents, under the laws of Wisconsin.
