The Principal/Assistant Principal/teacher in charge of a school may suspend a pupil in accordance with Wisconsin Statute 120.13(1)(b).

Conferences with parents/guardians of suspended pupils are encouraged. The Principal/Assistant Principal shall request a conference with the parents of the suspended pupil after the second suspension and subsequent suspensions during the school year. Continued out of school suspensions may result in the involvement of the District Administrator and/or the school board in a closed session.

A copy of the applicable State Statute shall be photocopied on the back of the suspension letter.
