

Physical Education

Fitness

- Activities to improve cardiovascular endurance, flexibility, muscular strength and endurance.
- Promote an understanding of the importance of a healthy lifestyle.

Gross Motor Coordination

- Large muscle groups working together
- Locomotor-running, jumping, skipping, etc.
- Non-locomotor-twisting, bending, balancing, etc.
- Activities involving the use of skills in lead-up games (ex. Basketball)

Hand-eye/Foot-eye Coordination (Fine Motor)

- Smaller muscle groups working together
- Targeting, throwing, kicking, dribbling, catching, manipulatives (bean bags, juggling, etc.)

Socialization Skills

- Sportsmanship
- Teamwork
- Understanding differences in abilities
- Goal setting and self improvement

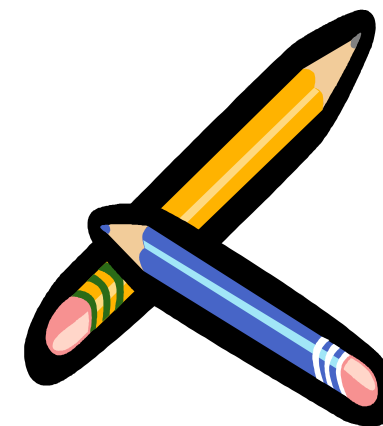

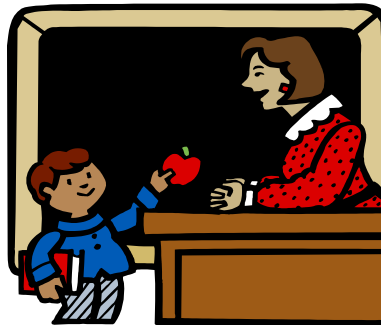
Learning Experiences Offered In Art, Library, Music & Physical Education

Art Education

- Develops a child's capacity to express feelings in a personal way
- Increase fine motor skills
- Enhances creative problem solving skills as children face situations which often have no clear-cut answers
- Develops aesthetic awareness, creativity & perceptual abilities by providing a basis for lifelong learning & self-fulfillment
- Expands critical thinking skills which strengthen children's abilities to make qualitative decisions in all aspects of their lives
- Broadens students' awareness of other cultures and their own
- Provides new approaches to learning when taught cooperatively with other subjects

Library Education

- Introduction to the library media center
- Promote proper book care
- Develop listening skills through storytime
- Motivate student reading through book talks
- Exposure to computerized catalog system
- Participate in weekly book check-out
- Experience dramatics/storytelling
- Reinforce social skills
- Create an understanding of basic reference works
- Highlight print and non-print materials
