High School and Middle School Bus Drop-off - Johnson Bus will drop-off high school students at KHS Door 2 (near the tennis courts) and then proceed to KMS Door 2 (east door) to drop-off middle school students.

High School and Middle School Bus Pick-up - Johnson Bus will pick-up all middle and high school students, at the end of the school day, along the bus lane located on the east side of the campus (between the middle and high schools).

Parent Traffic - Traffic flow will be more restricted this year. We ask for your patience and that you plan ahead to give yourself a little more time.

- Drop-off and pick-up at the middle school will be routed around a temporary parking lot outside of the middle school. Similar to previous years, parent traffic will be stopped by a staff member when the buses are ready to move. Drop-off and pick-up will be on the south side of the temporary parking lot. Students will then utilize the crosswalk to enter/exit the middle school.
- Drop-off and pick-up for high school students will remain the same as previous years, which is in front of the main high school entrance.

Student Parking

On-site student parking - will be reduced during the 2017-18 school year. However, Regal Ware has graciously allowed us to lease 100 spaces in their lot this year. These spaces will be marked and part of the KHS student purchased parking passes. Please know parking in unauthorized spaces and other private lots may result in tickets issued by the Police Department, and the owners of the lots do have the right to tow unauthorized vehicles.

Parking passes will be available on a first come/first serve basis for juniors and seniors beginning Monday, August 21. A completed *Parking Permit Application* and payment need to be turned in to the KHS office to obtain parking passes. Passes will become available to all remaining students beginning Monday, August 28.

Off-site student parking - Reigle Drive and Wildlife Drive will be available for student parking. Please pay attention to where the curb is yellow - do not park in these areas. Students are encouraged to pull forward as they park to reduce the need for parallel parking and/or lost space.

As a district we encourage you to plan ahead. Ask your child(ren) to utilize the bus service as often as possible and/or share rides with friends/neighbors to reduce the number of vehicles needing to park in the area.
