Please submit the following materials:

1. Application

2. Teacher's Recommendation and/or Coach, Principal or School Counselor

Please note to Applicant: After you have filled in your name, etc., give your form to your teacher, coach, principle or school counselor.

3. Non-Relative Recommendation

Please note to Applicant: After you have filled in your name, etc., give your form to your non-relative.

Applicant: Please return application, teacher's recommendation and non-relative recommendation to Student Services.

Tips for Applying:

1. Word process your entire application. If you must print the application form, write neatly and legibly.
2. Spend a good amount of time thinking about why you think this opportunity is important. An essay that fails to address required elements will not succeed. Focus on school and/or community involvement, achievements, awards and future goals. Incorporate how your college experience will help you achieve your goals. When writing about an experience, highlight what you accomplished through specific details and examples. Your essay should attempt to answer the following questions:
 - Why am I applying for this scholarship?
 - Why have I selected my major/area of study and what interests me about it?
 - Why am I attending my chosen college/university?
 - What are my future career objectives?
3. Have at least three people review your application.
4. DO NOT rely on spell check alone.
5. Turn in your application ahead of the deadline to apply.
6. Ask for your letters of recommendation early. This is very important.

REMEMBER - your scholarship application represents you!
