

# Scholarship Application Tips

*Where to find the application:*

There is one common application for all scholarships listed in the KEYS/Local Scholarship Program. This application is a fillable Google Doc. Your transcript will be released to the scholarship committee. This includes all courses and grades earned, school activity involvement, ACT scores, Laude Score.

Some of the larger scholarships require an interview. Student Services will notify you if you are selected. You will be expected to dress up, so plan ahead. Dress to impress!

Be patient, this process takes until late April. There are many different committees that review your application. Scholarships are awarded from top dollar on down. If you receive the J.O. Reigle Scholarship you are no longer considered for any of the KEYS/Local Scholarships. Once you receive a scholarship from the KEYS/Local program, your application is pulled from the pool and you are not considered for any others.

If you are selected to receive a scholarship, you will receive a formal letter in the mail. Anyone that is selected for a local scholarship is expected to attend the Scholarship Ceremony on Wednesday, May 15<sup>th</sup> at 7:00 pm in the Kewaskum High School Theatre. If you are selected for a scholarship you are expected to send a thank you card or letter to the sponsor of your scholarship!

As scholarships are awarded, we will update the list posted in Student Services.

Pay attention to the deadline! No late applications will be considered.

All applications must be submitted by: Wednesday, December 19<sup>th</sup> 2018

*The J.O. Reigle and West Bend Children's Theatre Scholarship require letters of recommendation. Please give 2 weeks notice when asking someone to write a letter for you. Most other scholarships do not consider letters of recommendation so please don't submit them unless required. (We have forms that you may want to use for this in Student Services and on our website).*
