

## **EMERGENCIES**

### **TELEPHONE**

The camp has a phone in their camp office. In the event of an emergency involving your child, you will be contacted immediately. We will be taking the KMS registration cards containing your home, work, and emergency contact phone numbers.

### **MEDICATION**

All medication **MUST** be turned into the teacher-in charge (Mrs. Wilson). It will be collected the morning of camp before we get on the busses. This is for the safety and protection of all students. The medication should be in the original container, with the proper dosage clearly listed and placed in a Ziploc bag. Please include the Medication form.

The camp requires that all medication be kept locked up while we are at camp. It will be distributed to the students by the teacher-in-charge, day or night, as needed.
