RE: East Central Conference Winter Sports Protocols

The Athletic Directors, Principals, and Superintendents of the East Central Conference have released the following information for the upcoming winter sports seasons. With the current COVID-19 pandemic, all parties have worked hard in creating protocols for all events - including those in which we are members of a different conference. These protocols cover everything from pre-practice through competition experiences. The protocols were created to fit the needs of each school district in the conference so as to provide uniformity between all locations, so expectations are clear and the same from event to event.

With the idea to provide the best possible situation for our student-athletes to have their athletic seasons and for their families to be able to attend, there will be an attendance limit at events. These limits are outlined below. There will be **NO GENERAL ADMISSION** tickets sold or available. Each athlete will be provided passes/tickets for the specific sport that will be distributed by their family. This pass/ticket will provide you admission to the event. If you do not have a pass/ticket, entry will not be allowed.

- Indoor Events – Basketball
 - 2 tickets per participant. Face coverings are REQUIRED. Social distancing is to be maintained, as well.
 - KML will be allowing 4 tickets per participant.
 - Winneconne will not be allowing spectators, at this time.
- Indoor Events – Wrestling
 - 2 tickets per participant. Face coverings are REQUIRED. Social distancing is to be maintained, as well.

While we are happy to provide the opportunity and experiences to our student-athletes, there are other portions of the events that will not be taking place. There will be no designated student passes/student sections.
