

SENIOR SEMINAR STUDENT REQUIREMENTS

1. The studies undertaken in a senior seminar class must be above and beyond the regular curriculum. What is covered in the seminar should not be the same curriculum as an advanced class in the subject area.
2. Seminars are only available to seniors. The student must have a 2.75 GPA in the subject area and an overall 2.0 GPA.
3. Students must complete the application process by April 1st for a tri 1 seminar course and October 1st for tri 2 & 3 seminar courses. The plan will have to be approved by the seminar teacher and the high school administration. The application must include this signed form along with a signed Senior Seminar Application Form.
4. The student and teacher must meet as often as the teacher requires, but **at least once a week**. The teacher may require that the student meet with him/her every day during a class period. The student will be scheduled for one class period daily for the seminar class.
5. The student will be required to keep a weekly journal throughout the trimester demonstrating knowledge gained through the seminar.
6. **At the end of the seminar the student will meet with a team to include teachers and an administrator or school counselor to report on their seminar.** The student will be primarily responsible for determining how to best demonstrate to this team that the completed work and information gained merits 0.5 credit.
7. Each teacher may not have more than 2 seminar students per trimester.
8. The student is accountable for turning in all work to the teacher at the designated time.
9. Students may not receive more than 1.0 credit for seminar classes.
